Does the PCBU operate mobile plant ie Tractor, Forklift, Quad Bike, mobile elevated work platforms

Does the PCBU have traffic management systems in place?

Traffic management plan Physical barriers

Are tractors fitted with ROPS? If not consider Imp Notice (cl.216)		
Is all plant adequately guarded? In particular PTO output shafts on tractors Consider Imp Notice (c1208)		
Is plant adequately maintained? Consider general condition, brakes, tyres, prestart checklists		
Does plant have safe access and egress to prevent slips and falls?		
Are Quad bikes fitted with OPD's?		
Do Quad bike operators wear helmets?		
Do EWP operators wear safety harnesses?		
Do workers travel on bin trailers?		
Not recommended. But if so fitted with platform and hand rails or handholds to safely accommodate this? Platforms should be behind axle.		
Work at Heights/ Ladders	Yes	No
Are workers trained in the use of picking ladders?		
What form does this take?		
And leading and association of O. N. A.		
Are ladders adequately maintained? Not bent, cracked, foot plates with spikes in place?		
Are ladders manufactured to Australian Standard AS1892.1?		
Recommended, in particular treads/rungs should be corrugated, serrated or coated with skid resistant material to prevent slips and falls ie: no round smooth pipe rungs		
Look for AS sticker or stamp		
Are workers instructed in the use of a picking bag including employing 3 points of contact when climbing up and down ladders?		

Are picking bags in serviceable condition, free from rips and tears, shoulder straps with padding intact? Adjustable straps and fasteners in working order?	
Do workers wear closed in, non- slip foot wear?
